No problems with Miriam Vale water supply

Mayor George Creed has confirmed that Miriam Vale's town water supply is a registered drinking water scheme meeting potable standards prescribed by the *Australian Drinking Water Guidelines*.

"The town water supply in Miriam Vale is tested regularly and meets the relevant drinking water standards," Cr Creed said.

Mayor Creed was responding to questions raised by the State Member for Burnett, Rob Messenger.

"Despite suggestions to the contrary by Mr Messenger, residents have no reason to be concerned about drinking from the town supply in Miriam Vale."
